

Key Questions

- Should MCP still stand alone as its own file?
- Should MCP files explicitly “point” to other files?
 - Touchstone
 - IBIS-ISS
 - ICM
 - IBIS
 - EBD
 - PKG
 - EMD (for future development)?
- Should other specs “point” to MCP definitions?
- MCP appears within subcircuit definitions
 - Should this be preserved (MCP as “top-level” only)?
 - Should MCP be made part of IBIS-ISS (or another spec)?
- How to resolve MCP conflicts with PARHIER (hierarchy)?
 - Do net names extend down multiple subcircuit levels?

* Other names and brands may be claimed as the property of others

- Remove company-specific references
- Change spec definition from a "block that is inserted into a host file as a comment section" to:
 - A separate file (?)
 - Not commented
- [Rem] will be maintained, but other comment characters may be allowed (per IBIS)
