




SAE ITC FRAMEWORK

SAE Technical Committees

- Technical Committees are responsible for the preparation, development, maintenance and promotion of all relevant standards within their scope.
- Each Technical Committee is required to have a charter which shall address scope, committee purpose and program of work.
- Technical committees consist of technical experts from government, industry, regulatory agencies and academia.

SAE COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP LEVELS

- Open to all with an interest and expertise
- □ 4 levels of membership:
 - Leadership Chair, Vice-Chair, Secretary
 - Member voting duty, must attend majority of meetings and contribute to committee
 - Liaison has access to workspace; can make technical comments; may be involved in standards or meetings
 - Mailing List Limited access to workspace, receives updates on standards


