Original IBIS Quality Levels

- 0** **Ibischk plus a few manual checks**
- 1** **All manual checks**
- 2a** **All manual checks plus simulation correlation**
- 2b** **All manual checks plus measurement correlation**
- 3** **All manual checks plus all correlation**

Proposed IBIS Quality Levels

- Correctness checks:
 - 0 Unchecked, quality unknown
 - 1 Passes ibischk
 - 2 Ibischk plus basic manual checks
 - 3 Ibischk plus all manual checks
- Correlation and notes:
 - M** Measurement correlated
 - S** Simulation correlated
 - X** eXemptions

Example: 2SX

Should we change it?

- **Pro:**
 - **Level 0 should be reserved for files not checked or not passing ibischk**
 - **Measurement and simulation are decoupled from checking**
 - **Reserves room for higher levels of checking**
- **Con:**
 - **Old system is in use (not extensively though)**
 - **Old system is compatible with IBIS Accuracy Specification**
